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Lane Closures on Area Roads

Chipley – Drivers are reminded to practice caution while traveling in and around the work zones in Northwest Florida Sunday, Nov. 6 through Saturday, Nov. 12.

Bay County:

- **23rd Street Flyover Project at State Road (S.R.) 30 (U.S. 98)** – Workers continue work on the permanent bridge foundation on the north side of U.S. 98 and are laying pipes for stormwater drainage. Crews are also constructing Pond #2 between Hannah Avenue and Stephen Avenue.
- Night time lane closures are taking place on **Harrison Avenue from Airport Road to east of 19th Street** as workers install a multi-use path, sidewalk, minor drainage, curb and gutter, signage, pavement markings and signalization. Improvements also include sidewalk, curb and gutters, signage, pavement markings and signalization on Harrison Avenue from U.S. 231 to Airport Road. Work is scheduled to be complete winter 2017.
- Lane closures for **Ironman Florida**, Saturday, Nov. 5. Drivers will encounter lane closures from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. on U.S. 98 (Front Beach Road), State Road (S.R.) 79, S.R. 20 and S.R. 77.
- A safety improvement project to install dual left turn lanes on **U.S. 98 (S.R. 30) at Richard Jackson Boulevard** will begin Nov. 14, 2016. Work is anticipated to be complete winter 2017.
- Lane closures will take place Monday, Nov. 7 and Tuesday, Nov. 8 on the **23rd Street Posten Bayou Bridge**. The westbound outside lane will be closed as crews perform routine bridge maintenance work from 8 p.m. to 4 a.m.

Gulf County:

- **S.R. 30 (U.S. 98) from the Gulf County Canal Bridge to South of U.S. 98 realignment** – Drivers will encounter temporary lane closures as workers pave the corridor.

Jackson County:

- **S.R. 73 from the Calhoun County line to County Road 167 (South Street)** – Workers have installed a temporary diversion south of Peacock Bridge to allow crews to install a cross drain, drivers will encounter temporary delays in the work zone. Paving work is taking place along the corridor. Drivers can expect lane closures Monday, Nov. 7 through Friday, Nov. 11.
- **S.R. 77 from the Alabama State line to Graceville** – Construction is underway. Workers will resurface the roadway, add signage, and install new pavement markings. Lane closures will remain in effect Monday through Saturday.
- **S.R. 71 from U.S. 90 to the Alabama State line** – Temporary lane closures will take place through November 30 as workers perform routine maintenance activities along the

corridor. Video pipe inspection work is also taking place in Malone between 5th Avenue and 13th Avenue.

- Drivers will encounter alternating lane closures Tues. Nov. 8 from 8 p.m. to 4 a.m., on the **U.S. 231 Spring Creek bridge**, two miles north of S.R. 2 as crews seal the bridge.

All planned construction activities are weather dependent and may be rescheduled in the event of inclement weather. Drivers are reminded to pay attention to the reduced speed limit when traveling through the construction area.
