## **Routine Interstate 10 Bridge Inspection in Holmes County**

*Chipley, FL* – Eastbound Interstate 10 drivers will encounter lane restrictions over Sandy Creek and Reedy Creek Bridges near State Road 81 (Mile Marker 96, Ponce de Leon) in Holmes County Wednesday, March 9 and Thursday, March 10. Lane closures will be in effect from 7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. as crews perform a routine inspection.

Routine inspections are one tool the department uses to provide a safe transportation system, an example of the dedication to making travel in Florida safer and more efficient.

All activities are weather dependent and may be delayed or re-scheduled in the event of inclement weather. Motorists are reminded to travel with care through the work zone and to watch for construction equipment and workers entering and exiting the roadway.

## **Underground Utility Work on State Roads in Escambia County**
