Kick-Off Meeting on State Road 79 Project Development and Environment Study

Chipley, FL –The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will hold a public kick-off meeting concerning the State Road 79 Project Development and Environment (PD&E) Study from S.R. 8 (I-10) to the Florida/Alabama state line in Holmes County. The meeting will be held Thursday, March 24 from 5:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. CDT at Northside Assembly of God, 1009 Rangeline Street, Bonifay.

The intent of the study is to investigate capacity improvements that include: widening from a two-lane to a four-lane roadway, a potential by-pass around the city of Bonifay, and potential one-way pairs within the city of Bonifay. The study will also examine all major intersections regarding safety and operational improvements. The meeting will be held in an open-house format and will include an informational video. FDOT representatives will be available to discuss proposed improvements, answer questions, and receive comments. Maps, drawings and other project information will be on display.
