## **Nighttime Lane Closures on State Road 85**

Chipley, FL – Motorists traveling State Road (S.R.) 85 will encounter lane restrictions near the intersection of S.R. 123 from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. Tuesday, May 31 through Saturday, June 4 as crews perform construction activities along the roadway.

Construction activities are weather dependent and may be delayed or rescheduled in the event of inclement weather. Drivers are reminded to use caution and watch for construction workers and equipment entering and exiting the roadway.

## Southbound Traffic Shift on Gap Creek Bridge

Chipley, FL – Drivers traveling State Road 189 (Beal Parkway) at Gap Creek Bridge will encounter intermittent lane restrictions from 11 p.m. Thursday, June 2 to 6 a.m. Friday, June 3 as crews make preparations to transition traffic from the median to the newly constructed southbound roadway. Crews will then complete work in the median, lay the final layer of asphalt (friction course) and stripe the roadway. Motorists are reminded to use caution and obey the posted speed limit when traveling through the work zone. The project is slated for completion early July.
