FDOT to Hold Public Hearing Regarding U.S. 90 Safety Improvements in Pace

Chipley, FL – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will hold a public hearing concerning safety improvements to U.S. 90 (State Road 10) at 5th Avenue, East of Bridgewater Drive (Pace Professional Park), Summerdale Boulevard, East of Dogwood Drive, and Chavers Street. The hearing will be held Thursday, August 4 from 5:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. CDT at the Immanuel Baptist Church, 4187 U.S. 90, Pace.

The intent of the project is to improve safety at the existing median openings to include median modifications, right and left turn lane construction, minor widening, and minor drainage upgrades. FDOT will receive bids for construction summer 2017. No additional right-of-way will be needed to construct the safety improvements.

The hearing will be held in an open-house format beginning at 5:30 p.m. with a brief presentation provided at 6 p.m. Maps, drawings and other project information will be on display. Public participation is solicited without regard to race, color, national origin, age, sex, religion, disability, or family status.
