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## FDOT Traffic Alert for Big Bend Area

**Chipley** – Drivers are reminded to practice caution while traveling in and around the work zones in Northwest Florida, the week of Sunday, Aug. 7 to Saturday, Aug. 13. Temporary lane closures, delays and shifts may occur as workers perform construction activities. All construction activities are weather dependent and may be delayed or rescheduled in the event of inclement weather. Motorists are reminded to pay attention and use caution when driving through the work zone.

## Gadsden County:

- I-10 from west of U.S. 90 to the Leon County Line, between mile marker (MM) 194 to west of MM 192. Drivers will encounter lane closures Sunday, Aug. 7 through Friday morning, Aug. 12 from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- Resurfacing on **State Road (S.R.) 12 from Yon Creek Bridge to west of U.S. 90**. Lane closures Monday, Aug. 8 through Saturday, Aug. 13 from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. as workers resurface the roadway. Traffic flaggers will direct motorists through the work area.

## Jefferson County:

- I-10 resurfacing from MM 225 to MM 236. Day time delays taking place along the corridor.
- **I-10 resurfacing from MM 217 to MM 222**. Construction activities are taking place along the corridor. Lane closures will remain in effect from Sunday, Aug. 7 through Friday morning, Aug. 12 from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- Day time delays taking place on S.R. 59 (Gamble Road) resurfacing project from County Road (C.R.) 259 (Tram Road) to S.R. 20 (U.S. 27).

• I-10 Westbound Rest Area near MM 233 – Rest area closed for renovations. Leon County:

- Nighttime resurfacing on S.R. 20 (Apalachee Parkway) from Monroe Street to Capital Circle NE from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, Aug. 7 through Thursday, Aug. 11. Workers are performing construction activities along the corridor.
- Workers paving U.S. 90 from Apex Drive to east of C.R. 59. Work is winding down on this project.
- Workers adding a new northbound lane to S.R. 63 (U.S. 27) from south of Lakeshore Drive to north of John Knox Road.

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- I-10 Leon County Rest Areas. Rest area renovations and repairs are complete for the westbound facility at MM 196. Eastbound facility remains closed at MM196 for renovations.
- Work to resurface and add paved shoulders on S.R. 263 (Capital Circle SW) from west of S.R. 61 (U.S. 319) to north of C.R. 2203 (Springhill Road) is underway. Drivers will encounter lane closures Monday, Aug. 8 through Thursday, Aug. 11 from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- S.R. 61 / U.S. 319 (Thomasville Road) from north of Lawton Chiles to south of Timberwolf Crossing. Driver will encounter temporary lane closures from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Thursday, Aug. 8 through Aug. 11 as crews install turn lanes.
- Driveway construction will take place Wednesday, Aug. 10 on Thomasville Road at Ocleon Drive. The northbound outside lane will be closed from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.

## Wakulla County:

- Motorists will encounter intermittent lane closures on U.S. 319 (Crawfordville Highway) from U.S. 98 north to Alaska Way, Monday, Aug. 8 through Friday, Aug 12. Lane closures remain in effect from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. to accommodate construction activities throughout the project area. Workers are clearing the work zone, performing utility work, constructing embankment and performing pipe operations.
- Shared Use Path construction is taking place near S.R. 375 (U.S. 319) from Ochlockonee Bay Trail to Surf Road.

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
