Lane Closures on Area Roads

Chipley – Drivers are reminded to practice caution while traveling in and around the work zones in Northwest Florida, the week of Sunday, Aug. 26 to Saturday, Sept. 3.

Bay County:

- State Road (S.R.) 30 (U.S. 98) at S.R. 368 (23rd Street), 23rd Street Flyover –Work is starting on the permanent bridge foundation. Workers continue to pile drive pilings and tie-in reinforced steel for the permanent bridge foundation. Concrete pilings are being delivered for the permanent bridge ramp.
- S.R. 30A (U.S. 98/15th Street) from west of Jenks Avenue to east of East Avenue Construction is complete.
- TECO People Gas will locate utilities on **U.S. 231 south of Mill Bayou**, Sunday, Aug 28. The southbound outside lane will be closed from 7 p.m. to 5 a.m.

Calhoun County:

• S.R. 71 from S.R. 69 (Pear Street) to the Jackson County line –Temporary lane closures will take place as workers wrap up construction activities along the corridor.

Gulf County:

• S.R. 30 (U.S. 98) from the Gulf County Canal Bridge to South of U.S. 98 realignment – Resurfacing work is underway along the corridor, drivers will encounter temporary lane closures.

Jackson County:

- S.R. 73 from the Calhoun County line to County Road 167 (South Street) Construction crews are installing erosion control methods along the corridor. Signs are erected alerting drivers of upcoming work.
- S.R. 77 from the Washington County line to south of Brown Street- Construction activities are underway along the eight-mile corridor. Drivers can anticipate temporary delays Monday, Aug. 29 through Wednesday, Aug. 31, beginning at 7:30 a.m.
- Routine mitered end replacement work will take place on **S.R. 69** Monday, Aug. 22 through, Friday, Oct. 28. Drivers will encounter temporary lane closures for material deliveries.
- Temporary lane closures for video pipe inspections will continue through Friday, Oct. 14 on S.R. 10 (U.S. 90), S.R. 71, S.R. 77, S.R. 276 and S.R. 73 (S.R. 166). Work will take place Sunday night from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. and Monday through Thursday, 7 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- Routine bridge maintenance will take place through Tuesday, Aug. 30 on **S.R. 2 over Marshall Creek (6.5 miles east of U.S. 231)**. Drivers will encounter north and south bound lane restriction from 8 p.m. to 4 a.m.

All planned construction activities are weather dependent and may be rescheduled in the event of inclement weather. Drivers are reminded to pay attention to the reduced speed limit when
