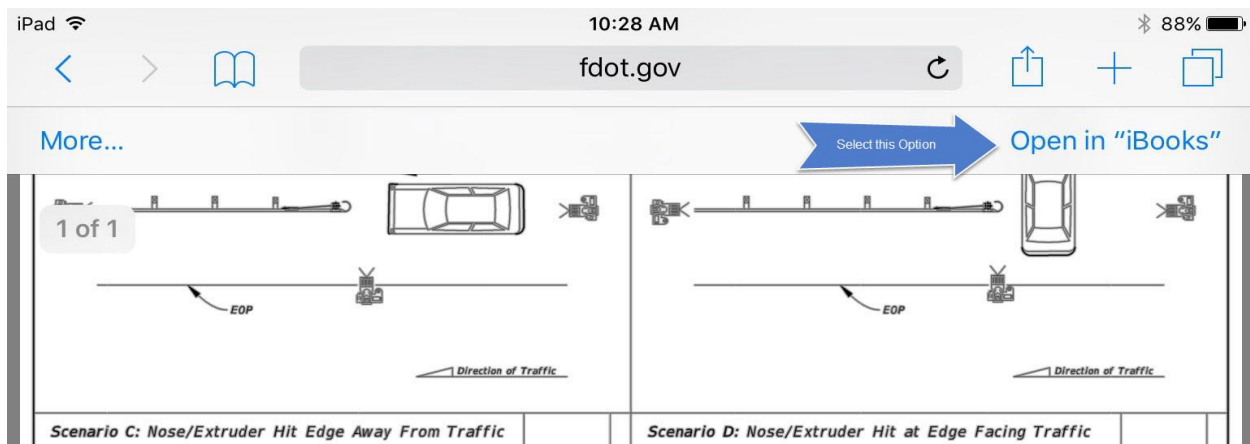
## How to add PDF's to your mobile device

- 1.) On the ISPE website there are PDF documents that users will need to have so they can identify inventory types as well as a few other things. So user will not have to access the website every time they want to view these PDF's. User will need to save them to mobile device for easy access.
- 2.) To have these PDF's user will access the ISPE website in mobile device browser or from link provided. [ISPE Website](#)
- 3.) Once user is on website page you'll then select the PDF document you would like to view.

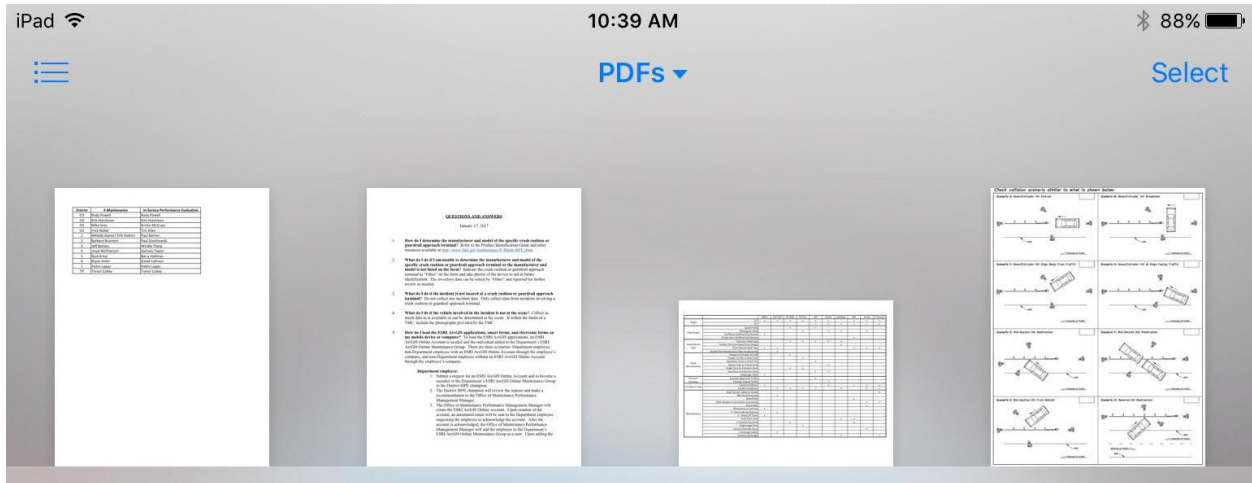

- 4.) Once PDF opens on device you'll see an option "Open in iBooks"/PDF Reader. Select that option. (This option will not stay on the screen for long).



5.) All PDF's that are opened in iBooks/PDF Reader will be saved to mobile device within the iBooks/PDF Reader application.



Side Note: All Department Apple devices have iBooks installed on them. If user would rather use Adobe you can set it to be the default and save PDF Documents there.

If you **do not** have Adobe Acrobat on either Apple or Android device but would like it, put in a service desk ticket to have it installed.
